

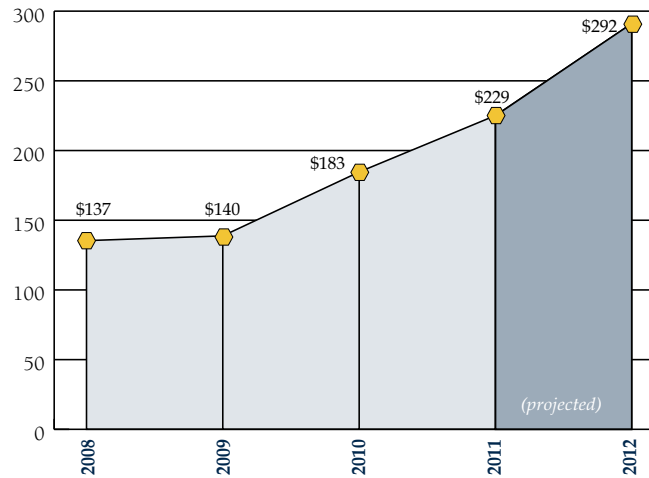
Economic Impact of the 2012 Indiana Companies to Watch

INCREASING INFLUENCE

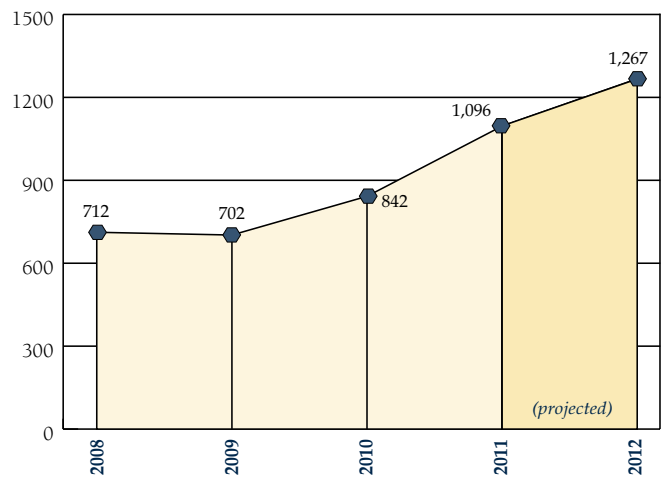
From 2008 through 2011, these companies generated \$688 million in revenue and added 384 employees (both in Indiana and out of state), reflecting a 67% increase in revenue and 54% increase in jobs for the four-year period. That translates into 19% annual revenue growth and 16% annual growth in employees.

These companies project continued growth in 2012, with a 28% revenue increase and 16% growth in employees (both in Indiana and out of state) compared to 2011. If their projections hold, these companies will have generated \$980 million in revenue and added 555 employees over the last five years – a 113% increase in revenue and 78% increase in jobs since 2008.
